A supply chain encompasses all steps in transferring products from the manufacturer to the end customer. Optimizing this process allows it to function at peak efficiency.

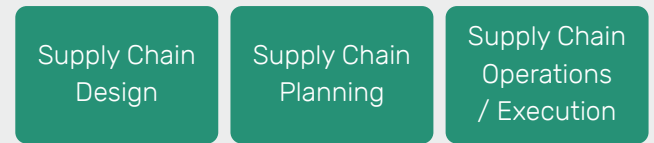
