

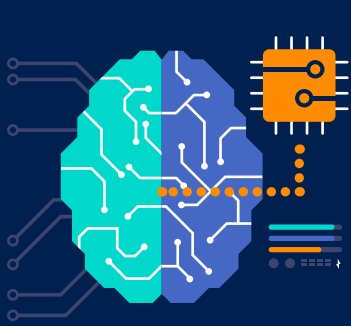
READY FOR THE DIGITAL FUTURE?

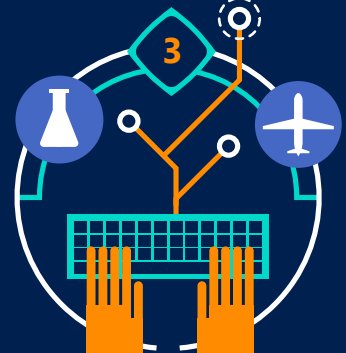

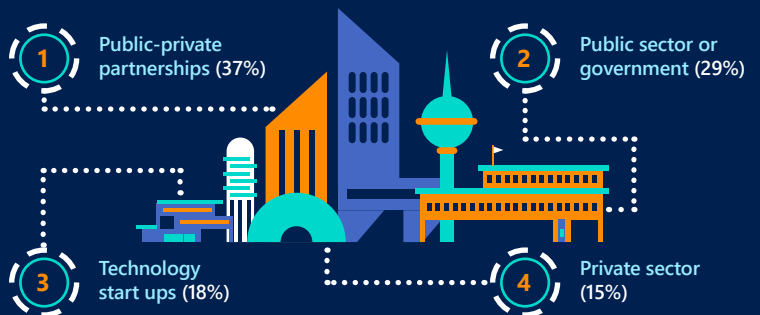
